The 5th Indonesia Performing Arts Mart (IPAM) 2009 offers a unique opportunity for global interactive agents in the performing arts industry to become acquainted with this exotic, richly faceted, singular culture, to boost international cultural exchange programmes and experiences as well as know-how gained in the field of worldwide touring, attracting sponsors and fund raising. IPAM 'performers' are performing arts groups from various regions of Indonesia. Each performer will present their latest work in the form of dance, music, theatre and other types of performing arts both traditional and modern. The 'presenters' are worldwide performing arts agents, performing arts managers, impresarios, event organizers, artists, curators, and other performing arts enthusiasts.

### WORKSHOP

The workshop will be conducted by the committee to give general perspective about IPAM and to give ideas on how Indonesian performing arts groups could gain benefits from their participation in IPAM. Some performing arts experts will share their experiences with the arts managers and artists.

### SEMINAR

A half day seminar entitled "Global Creative-Industry Opportunities" will take place at Sahid Jaya Hotel on 4th of June. The main issue discussed at the seminar is on the performing arts prospects and development. All presenters, performing arts managers, artists, curators, local government stakeholders, academicians, event organizers, impresarios and other performing arts experts are invited. International speakers are going to share their experience at the seminar.

### SHOWCASES

The performing arts presentation (showcases) will take place at Teater Besar and Teater Kecil of the Indonesia Institute of the Arts (ISI) Surakarta on 4th, 5th and 6th of June. Each performing arts group will present their work for about 30 minutes. There are more than 10 showcases during the three-day programme. This category includes dance, theatre, music, pantomime, monologue and all kinds of performing arts.

### ARTS EXHIBITIONS

Any performing arts group, performing arts agent or other performing arts institutions may take part and exhibit their works at the arts exhibition which takes place at Pendopo Hall of the Indonesia Institute of the Arts (ISI) Surakarta from 3rd – 7th of June. Booths and audio visual equipments are available on request. The exhibitions include an international performing arts co- promotion and fringes.

### NETWORKING PROGRAMME

International presenters, performing arts group managers and artists will have an opportunity to develop networking and friendship during the hosted lunch and dinner as well as during the cultural excursions.

### BUSINESS FORUM

Performing arts managers, artists, presenters, performing arts agents, impresarios, event organizers may meet each other at the exhibition venue or booth on 4th, 5th, 6th of June to discuss future cooperation possibilities.

### CULTURAL EXCURSIONS

Presenters and performing arts group managers are invited to join cultural excursions and networking lunch on 5th and 6th of June.

### CLOSING CEREMONY

Presenters and performing arts group managers are invited to the closing ceremony on 6th of June.
